Project Detail: The new 80,000 SF classroom building on UCF's main campus is a partnership between UCF, the Army and Air Force ROTC departments. The project includes high tech lecture halls equiped with state of the art classroom technology. The collaborative learning spaces satisfy a



need for additional specializied teaching space for ROTC programs to further US Army and Air Force cadet training and education.

The architect reviewed Absorption Plus product Iterature including acoustic and fire test data and selected SPI panels due to fabrication experience with non standard fabric facings.
